Fourth Annual Report of the Young Ladies' Society.

Thirty-three meetings of this Society were held during the year, at which the average attendance was 12—19 being the largest number present at any meeting. The number of members on the roll is 28.

A social was held under the auspices of the Society in the month of April, the proceeds of which amounted to \$54.85, and a Christmas sale in December which yielded \$160.25.

The Society found it necessary during the year to purchase a sewing machine which cost \$30. Of this sum \$19.75 was collected by the members, the balance (\$10.25) being deducted from the proceeds of the sale.

The proceeds of this year have, as agreed upon at last annual meeting, been devoted to the Building Fund.
