#### See Air Commuting Within Ten Years

Experts Predict Development Like That of Automobiles 1905 to 1915

Washington, July 26-Airplanes will be used for business and pleasure in the United States within the next ten years United States within the next ten years on a scale commensurate with the extension of automobile traffic between 1905 and 1915, it is predicted in a statement issued by the Department of Chief of Air Service, War Department,

Experts of the Bureau of Standards say that people of moderate wealth will find air machines useful for commuting, for business trips and for week-end and

very greatly the distance to which such trips can be made in a given period of time. They will permit commuting from distances of a hundred miles, while week-end trips can be made from New York to the Thousand Isles; from San Francisco to Yosemite; from Washington and Baltimore to the mountains of Virginia, and from Boston to the Maine woods.
