Chicago, Nov. 27—Among the approximately 150 persons taken into custody as a result of the crime wave that swept Chicago in three days, in which holdups, automobile thefts and safe blowings followed in rapid sequence, sixteen men and a woman placed in city jails charged with implication in four murders, 100 saloon, pool room and street holdups, and 150 house burglaries. Members of the band confessed to the more than 250 crimes, police asserted.


