

New York, Oct. 29—The financial statement of the United States Steel Corporation for the third quarter of the calendar year, issued today, shows total earnings of \$30,063,312, and net earnings of \$20,774,465, representing gains of \$4,961,257 and \$2,348,171 respectively, compared with the preceding quarter.
