Not so very long ago an English rowing authority, in contrasting the systems which prevail in the United States and England, scolded our coaches for forcing their charges too hard in training, with the result that it has been the exception, according to the English theory, that the American eight has not been prostrated at the end of a race.

Very frankly it must be admitted that many a college crew has been "baked" at the end of a race in the United States. It has been the winner. Some have been so badly "baked" that there is no athletic element which the Americans can match in harder rowing than that of the English. On the other hand, the English crew here in which they overcame at the finish of the race.

Harvard has rowed proudly over the line at New Haven with every man upright in the boat. Cornell and Pennsylvania have done the same thing at Poughkeepsie. Some of our best athletic clubs have boasted of eight that did equally well in races at shorter distances, but under trying conditions. That all English crews are impervious to the exertion of a hard and fast race is disproved by the photograph above, which shows the Cambridge crew at the finish in the last race against Oxford. Every man in the Cambridge boat is prostrated.

It is true that it was one of the hardest races on record between the English universities, but possibly the exertion which was called for was no greater than that which is demanded of the American university crews. In the season of the year in which rowing reaches its culmination in this country the heat is sometimes so trying that it is abominably oppressive.

Rowing experts may haggle until they are blind and deaf as to the merits of systems which are taught to crews in different countries, but the fact remains that no rowing system will save a crew from keeling over if the opposing eight is fast enough and possessed of enough endurance to make the other fellows row their limit.

FOX'S HORSES NOW QUARTERED AT MOOSEPAH

While the population of St. John was celebrating the Glorious Twelfth yesterday the first contingent of horses to race at Moosepah July 22, 23 and 24 arrived in the city. They are now quartered at the track. The rest of the horses are expected to reach the track today.

Frank Fox's string of ten horses arrived in a palace horecar at three o'clock yesterday. Fox's Gypsy Brazilian came in with the Fox string. Charles Gordon's Alberta G., also arrived yesterday. Mr. Fox will stay at the Three Mile House.

The horses will work out on the Moosepah track in preparation for next week's meet. The track is in good condition and some great racing is expected on the 22nd, 23rd and 24th. Work on the additional stalls is going ahead and it is expected that they will be completed by tomorrow night.

The largest attendance that Moosepah has had for several seasons is expected as the entries are numerous and have among them those of some of the best horses that have raced the Maritime Circuit. The special rates to be given by the transportation companies will make it easy for those in other places to reach St. John.

Billy Rolfe and Tom Foley are summering at Hough's Neck. Both boxers have been offered matches in Maine. After his contest with Ad. Volgaist, Battling Nelson will leave for New York, where he has promised to give an exhibition bout for the Newbaby's benefit.

Eddie Murphy, the South Boston lightweight, is contemplating a change of management. A western manager who has handled boxers with great success is after Murphy. Bergin has the distinction of having never been knocked out, which cannot be said for Cote. Bergin will defend his title against all comers at 133 pounds.

Hickman, the Brockton player, who has been out of the game because of rowdism, has been reinstated and fined \$50. Harrisburg, of the Tri-State league, has released Swacina, who was with Pittsburgh last year, and Bill McCarthy, the Roxbury boy, who has been catching.

Mike Donlin has received an offer of \$5,000 to manage the Stockton team of the California league, but turned down the offer, as he intends to leave for Europe, July 10. Chick Autrey, who was picked up to play first base for the Doves when they were on the last western trip, has been sent to Lynn of the New England league. President Dovey says he will be given the pick of the Lynn team at the end of the season in exchange.

Manzer Heckert, of the Harrisburg Club, of the Tri-State league will put up a fight for Martell, who was known as Jack Hanlon when with Steubenville. Martell recently joined the Philles. Heckert claims he bought Martell, and will go to the national commission to press his claim.
