 government opened a session tonight.
 Hon. J. P. Byrne, attorney general, and
 Hon. Robert Murray, provincial secre-
 tary, arrived this morning. Other

 pleased to accept the resignation of
 Francis Potier as labor act commis-
 sioner for the parish of Rogersville;
 to remove John Ryan as provincial
 constable of Bath, in Carleton, for
 cause; and to approve of the appoint-
 ment of Joshua B. Babirick, of Elgin,
 Albert Co., to be deputy sheriff.
