Manager's Report.

The manager's report contained the following facts:—Applications received in the clearing house service, 4,930; reports issued, 21,759; membership at the beginning of the year, 28 full and 4 associate; at present, 33 full, 4 associate, Assignments received 23.

A number of accounts were investigated to the mutual benefit of both debtors and creditors, but it was not possible to help in some cases and the businees had to go to an assignment. The finances of the association were reported in a satisfactory condition.

While it was quite true that several failures had taken place during the past three months, few of them had been important, and there was a hopeful feeling that business interest would not suffer severely under the prevailing depression. Adequate accounting was urged, for it had been found that in nearly every case lack of proper records was responsible for failure to carry en.

In Healthy State.

The report continued;
"The business of the maritime provinces may be regarded to be in a fairly healthy state, the pressure is heavy on those trading on limited capital, and it may be hard to secure adequate profit on sales to provide for expenditures and leave a margin; it is therefore suggested that every item of expense must be studied and limited to absolute needs.

There is unemployment in industrial centres which is being keenly felt; there is depression in many lines of business, usually profitable, which is holding up the collection of accounts by the merchants, receding values have also to be faced resulting in loss on merchanties bought at high prices but it is expected that these draw-
