The Sacrament of the Lord's Supper was observed four times as usual and the Sacrament of Baptism administered to 51 persons, two of whom were adults.

The choir rendered freely excellent service and in this connection we would not forget the voluntary service for over a year by Mr. Ballantyne as organist. After four years' faithful service, Mr. Freeland's resignation was accepted and Mr. Alexander appointed choirmaster and organist.

The Session would reverently acknowledge that Salvation is of the Lord and attribute to Him all that is worth recording in connection with the progress of His Kingdom in our midst and would conclude with the words of the Master, "This is My Commandment, that ye Love one another even as I have loved you."
