

Tilbury and Comber, and those Windfall and Strangfield, formed into a Mission Station, on the thirteenth day of December, 1887.

The congregation of Campbell Settlement was separated from the congregations of Leamington and Blythswood, and united to those of Windfall and Strangfield, on the twenty-eighth day of February, 1888.

Leamington and Blythswood were placed on the list of Mission Stations, on the twenty-eighth day of February, 1888.

The second church in St. Annes, Kankakee, Illinois, (American), was united with our church on the twenty-second day of April, 1888.

PRESBYTERY OF HURON,—

The Congregation of Chiselhurst was separated from Carmel Church, Hensal, on the thirteenth day of March, 1888.

PRESBYTERY OF BRUCE,—

Balacklava was transferred to the Presbytery of Saugeen, in the Synod of Toronto and Kingston, on the thirteenth day of June, 1887.

Spanish Mills was placed on the list of Mission Stations, on the thirteenth day of September, 1887.

ELECTION OF MODERATOR.

The roll having been called and the attendance marked, the Moderator addressed the Court and intimated that the first business as the election of a Moderator. Dr. James, Mr. John Gray and Mr. George Cuthbertson were severally proposed and seconded, when, on the vote being taken, Dr. James was elected by a majority.
