such Salmon, Maskinongé, Speckled Trout or Bass shall be found, shall incur a penalty of two pounds ten shillings for each Salmon or Maskinongé, and one pound five shillings for each Speckled Trout or Bass.

Act not to affect VI. Nothing in this Act shall extend or be construed to extend to any Indians now or hereafter to be resident within the limits of Upper Canada. 5

Penalties, and how recovered and amplied. VII. For each offence against any of the provisions of this Act for which no other penalty is hereby imposed, the offender shall incur a penalty of not less than two pounds ten shillings nor more than five pounds, in the discretion of the Justice or Justices before whom he shall be convicted; and any penalty imposed by this Act shall be recoverable 10 with costs, one half of such penalty shall go to the informer, and the other half to the municipality in which the offence shall have been committed, unless the informer shall renounce his share of the penalty, in which case the whole shall go to the municipality: if the penalty and costs to which any offender convicted under this Act be not forthwith 15 paid, the convicting Justice may commit him to the Common Gaol of the County or United Counties for a period not exceeding one month, unless such penalty and costs be sooner paid.

Public Act. VIII. This Act shall be a public Act.
