

BILL.

An Act to amend the Act 14th and 15th Victoria, cap. 126, intituled, "*An Act to amend an Act, intituled, 'An Act to compel Vessels to carry a Light during the night, and to make sundry provisions to regulate the Navigation of the Waters of this Province.'*"

WHEREAS the rapidly increasing intercourse by Steamboats and Sailing Vessels between the Lakes and the Gulf of St. Lawrence, renders it expedient that a uniform system should be adopted in regard to Vessels carrying Lights during the night; Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

That the third Section of the Act 14 and 15 Victoria, cap. 126, in the title to this Act mentioned, and so much of the said Act as limits the operation of any part thereof to Upper Canada, be and the same is, hereby repealed.

II. And be it enacted, That the first and second Sections of the said Act shall be in force in this Province, and applicable to all the navigable inland waters thereof, and to the River St. Lawrence as far down as Quebec.

III. And be it enacted, That this Act shall commence and be in force from and after the thirty-first day of December next.
