

and expenditures of all school moneys received and expended in
 2 behalf of such section for any purpose whatsoever, during such year ;
 and if such account shall not be satisfactory to a majority of the
 4 householders present at such meeting, then a majority of the said house-
 holders shall appoint one person, and the Trustees shall appoint
 6 another ; and the two arbitrators thus appointed shall examine the
 said account, and their decision respecting it shall be final : or, if the
 8 two arbitrators thus appointed shall not be able to agree, they shall
 select a third, and the decision of the majority of the arbitrators
 10 so chosen shall be final ; and such arbitrators or a majority of them,
 shall have authority to collect, or cause to be collected, whatever
 12 sum or sums may be awarded against any person or persons by them,
 in the same manner and under the same regulations as those according
 14 to which Trustees are authorised by the twelfth section of this Act to
 collect school rates ; and the sum or sums thus collected shall be
 16 expended in the same manner as are other moneys for the Common
 School purposes of such section.

18 *Nineteenthly.* To prepare and transmit, or cause to be prepared
 and transmitted annually, before the fifteenth day of January, a
 20 report to the local Superintendent ; which report shall be signed by
 the majority of the Trustees, and made according to a form provided
 22 by the Chief Superintendent of Schools, and shall specify :

1st.—The whole time the school in their section shall have been
 24 kept by a qualified Teacher during the year ending the thirty-first day
 of the previous December.

26 2ndly.—The amount of moneys received from the school fund, from
 local rates or contributions, and from other sources, distinguishing
 28 the same ; and the manner in which all such monies have been
 expended.

30 3rdly.—The whole number of children residing in the school
 section over the age of five years and under the age of sixteen ; the
 32 number of children and young persons taught in the school in winter
 and summer, distinguishing the sexes, and those who are over and
 34 under sixteen years of age ; the average attendance of pupils in both
 winter and summer.

36 4thly.—The branches of education taught in the school ; the
 number of pupils in each branch ; the text books used ; the number
 38 of public school examinations, lectures, and visits, and by whom,
 and such other information respecting the school premises, and
 40 library, as may be required in the form of report provided by the
 Chief Superintendent of Schools.

42 XIII. And be it enacted, That every Trustee of a common school
 who shall knowingly sign a false report, and every Teacher of a
 44 Common School who shall keep a false school register, or make a false
 return, with the view of obtaining a larger sum than the just
 46 proportion of school moneys coming to such Common School,
 shall, for each offence, forfeit to the Common School Fund of
 48 the Township, the sum of *five pounds*, and may be prosecuted
 before any such Justice of the Peace, by any person whatever, and
 50 convicted on the oath of any one credible witness other than the prose-
 cutor, and if convicted the said penalty shall, if not forthwith paid, be
 52 levied with costs by distress and sale of the goods and chattels of the
