Two,"—and the instrument of organization shall be the same as required for County Societies, except that the prescribed limits of the Society's operations shall be specified therein:

- 2. The County Society No. Two, shall be entitled to a share of the share of public grant, in the ratio of its subscription to those of the rest of the grant. County; it shall have the powers of a County Society, and shall be subject to the provisions of this Act relating to County Societies in Lower Canada:
- 3. The County Society No. Two, shall be entitled to a share of the Grant for 10 public grant for the year in which it is formed, if such formation has year of form-taken place before the first day of May.
