
Ottawa, April 28, 1909.

Sir,-

In the year 1906 a number of new desks were ordered for the Pointe Bleue school. The Inspector states that twelve more are required. The Department would like to know whether those at present in the school are single or double desks. If single, the twelve additional will be ordered, and you should state the ~~six~~ number of each size needed and the number of rear seats. It will probably be necessary to rearrange the seats and you should consult with the teacher, so that there may be no error in the sizes, the number of each and the number of rear seats.
