Pirst Witness for the Prosecution WR 170 Constable E O CROSSE, Mormouth Police Sta, MONMOUTH, being sworn states:

I then shone the light on it was accosting them. I then shone the light them again and the man on the left shouted, "It is them again and the man on the left shouted, "It is only a fucking policeman, we can knock his head off". The man on my left then wrestled with me for poss-The man on my left then wrestled with me for possession of my torch which he obtained. I then drew my staff and warned the men again that I was a police offr. The two men then took hold of the staff and my arm was twisted until I had to release it. The man on my left then raised the staff over my head with his right hand and said, "we can knock your with his right hand and said, "we can knock your man on my left then raised the staff over my head with his right hand and sold, "we can knock your head off and we will". He did not deliver a blow however, he closed with me and pinned my arms to my side. He then began to walk me backwards sand the man on my right landed two blows on my nach. The man on my right then said, "take your bloody glasses off so that we can hit you properly". Heither of the two men had hats on. I noticed that the man on my left had hair which was brushed back, the man on my right had hair which was brushed ing straight up. I cluded the men and went to phone for help from Monmouth. I also got another that men had vanished. I immediately made enquiries at whitebrook in compnay with two other police offra as a result of which we went to a gravel quarry whitebrook in company with two other police offra as a result of which we went to a gravel quarry mear Twalcok. The gd there took us to capt I E Seybold and we told him what had happened. After making a search of the camp he infa us all men were present. The time was then 0230 hrs 31 Aug. Is trin the day I returned to the quarry. I identified the panerd as the man who had been on my left and Gur Gray as the man who had been on my right.
