Q:- Had Foster intimated to you previously
that he was going to stop in Eecloo on the
water duty trip?
A:- No Sir.

The accused declines to cross-examine the

duly sworn, states:

I, H.195372 Gnr Crowe J W am a Driver Batman in HQ
2 Cdn AGRA. I was on guard here from 2000 hrs to
2320 hrs 27 Oct 44 when I was to be relieved by Gnr
Foster. Around 2200 hrs I saw Gnr Foster around the
kitchen, a little the worse for drink. About 2320 hrs
when I was due to be relieved I saw Gnr Mundle coming
out of the place where Gnr Foster sleeps and he told
me that Foster was not able to go on duty and that I
better carry on. I waited till Sgt Walker returned
and as I had to go on a recce early the next morning
I asked him to get someone to relieve me.

ACCUSED

Q:- What time did you say you came past the QM
Stores and saw Gnr Mundle?
A:- About 2320 hrs or so.
