Dear Brice,

The following information might be of use to you & is therefore sent:-  
A secondary meeting of Indians was held last night to fix problem their Boundaries for trapping purposes. They claim that Liard & Mc Dames Indians are the same & can be taken as one. There are few Indians now at Liard & some Liard here. This was allowed, but understood that when Liard Indians return, as they are expected to do, a Head Man will be set up there. The Boundary line is as follows:- Mouth Eagle Rv to Cotton Wood Rv up same to H/waters. Along H of Land & over Head of Ranchie & to H of Moose Rv. Thence to Sayer or Scurvy Creek & over to this side of Francis Lake some ways down Francis Rv. Thence to H of ~~Francis~~ Hylam Rv. to tip of Coal Rv - Beaver Rv. Smith Rv & Tobally Lake. Caribon Mt. to Devils Canyon on Liard - Muncho Lake along H of Land East of Toad Rv. - H of L to H/w Muddy Rv in to Eagle River. There was no kiok about

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
