Boundaries
Mc Barnes Head
Liard Indians

The following information might
be of use to you & is therefore sent:-
A secondary meeting of Indians was held last night
to fix permanent boundaries for trapping purposes.
They claim that Liard & Mc Barnes Indians are the
same & can be taken as one. There are few Indians now
at Liard & some Reid here - this was allowed, but understood
that when Reid Indians return, as they are expected to
do, a Head Man will be set up there. The Boundary line
is as follows:- Mouth Eagle Rv to Cotton Wood Rv up same to
H/waters along H of Land & over Head of Ranchim to H of Moose Rv
Thence to Sayer or Scary Creek & over to this side of Francis Lake
some ways down Narus Rv. Thence to H of ~~Black~~ Coal Hylans
Rv to tip of Coal Rv - Beaver Rv - Smith Rv & Totally Lake
Caribou MT to Devil's Canyon on Liard - Muncho Lake
along H of Liard East of Toad Rv. - H & L to Hwy Muddy Rv
in to Eagle River. There was no riot about

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
