¶ Instead of the Collect at the end of the Litany [We humbly beseech thee] shall the following be used.

O LORD, we beseech thee, mercifully hear our prayers, and spare all those who confess their sins unto thee ; they, whose consciences by sin are accused, by thy merciful Pardon may be absolved, through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

¶ Then shall the people say this that followeth, after the Minister

TURN us, O good Lord, and so shall we be turned. Be favourable, O Lord, be favourable to thy people, who turn to thee in fasting and prayer. For thou art a merciful God, full of compassion, long suffering, and of great pity. Thou sparest when we deserve punishment ; and in thy wrath, thinkest upon mercy. Spare thy people, good Lord, spare them, and let not thy heritage be brought to confusion. Hear us, O Lord, for thy mercy is great ; and after the multitude of thy mercies, look upon us, through the merits and mediation of Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*
