- "To the Serjeant at Arms attending the Assembly the sum of ten shillings perdiem, during the present session.
- "To the Door-keeper of the Council in General Assembly the fum of five shillings per diem, during the present session.
- "To the Door-keeper of the Assembly the sum of five shil-"lings per diem, during the present session."
- "To the Messenger the sum of five shillings per diem, during the present session.
- "To the Clerk of the Assembly for fuel, stationary, and other expences of the present session the sum of - - - -
- To the Treasurer of the Province for his past services the
- To the Tide Surveyor in the city of Saint John for his past fervices the sum of - - -
