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ICED BEVERAGES.

Liquid Refreshment For Suffering from Heat.

When the thermometer registers 90 degrees in the shade, the thoughts naturally turn to iced beverages, frozen foods and all of the nice unwholesome concoctions for which culinary skill is responsible, and, in spite of having been so often forewarned of the evil intentions of the virulent bacteria lying in wait in common ice for their victims, we still allow self-indulgence to win the day as we revel in these same injurious dishes with a reckless disregard of the aftermath. "Moderation in all things" bears an especial significance when applied to iced compounds, remarks a Table Talk writer in prefaces to the following recipes:

Fruit Effervescent Drinks.

To make the fruit effervescent drink, take one pint of the extracted juice of any kind of fruit, filter until clear, add to this two pounds of loaf sugar, one and one-half ounces of powdered tartaric acid. Boil six or eight minutes, bottle and cork. To a glass three parts full of water allow two tablespoonfuls of the sirup and twenty grains of bicarbonate of soda.

Egg Lemonade.

Make a thin sirup by boiling one and one-half pounds of water with two cups of sugar. Add the grated rind of one lemon and juice of two. Just before serving whip lightly in two eggs beaten separately and a small amount of bicarbonate of soda. Serve while foaming.

Spiced Beer.

Dissolve five pounds of loaf sugar in five gallons of water; to this add the juice of three lemons, three ounces of the essence of spruce and one cupful of yeast. Allow this to ferment in a warm place. Strain and bottle.

Tender.

Take one quart of strong tea, freshly made, add the grated rind of one orange, the juice of two lemons and one small cupful of sugar. Strain and add slices of oranges and pineapple or a few whole berries. Just before serving, turn in a bottle of soda water.

Seed Coffee With Fruit Flavor.

Dissolve two cupfuls of sugar in one quart of strong hot coffee. When cold, add one tablespoonful each of whipped cream and fruit flavor to a small cupful of coffee, or serve in glasses on cracked ice.

Canning Beans.

When it is possible, it is desirable to can the late crop of string beans, as it is more difficult to keep canned vegetables through dog days than through all the rest of the season. The string beans that are canned from the late crop of October are almost sure to keep, but those put up earlier may be a failure. Select the tender "runner" beans. Remove the strings, wash them well, throw them into boiling water and let them boil up once; fill glass cans with the scalded beans. Cover them with boiling water to which a cup of salt has been added for every gallon. Seal the cans up, leaving a vent open for air. Where ordinary jars are used, leave off the rubbers and simply screw on the covers. Place the jars containing the beans in a large boiler or a rack and let the water boil around them for one hour; then close the vent or, in case of the common jar, put on the rubbers. Fill up all of the jars with boiling salted water, and close them or screw on the tops as tight as possible. Some housekeepers as an extra precaution tie a square of cotton batting over the top of each jar.

How to Use Sour Cream.

Sour cream may be used in any recipe for cake or breakfast breads in which sweet milk, baking powder and shortening are required. The same quantity of cream is taken as when milk is called for, but the quantity of shortening is reduced and the baking powder is replaced by baking soda. The amount necessary of the last ingredient is in direct proportion to the quantity and acidity of the cream, the usual rule being one teaspoonful (level) of soda to one pint of thick sour cream. Soda is usually dissolved in a small teaspoonful of boiling water, added to the cream, stirred until the latter is foamy, then turned at once into the dry mixture. If the cream is well soured, the ingredients rapidly mixed and the oven properly heated the result will be very satisfactory, concluding a cooking expert.

In Days of Heat.

To cool a room, wet a cloth, suspend it, ventilate freely, and there will be an appreciable sensation of refreshment. Use a sheet in a large room.

TELEGRAPH ARRANGEMENTS.

Elaborate Though Simple System By Which Peace Is Kept At Portmouth, N.H., Keep in Touch With Home.

Complete are the telegraph and cable arrangements which have been made for the distinguished foreigners who are to meet here to try to make peace that, whether they be in the conference room at the Portsmouth Navy Yard or in their quarters in the Wentworth Hotel, they will be in touch on a minute's notice with St. Petersburg and Tokyo and with Oyster Bay and all the capitals of Europe.

The Postal Telegraph Cable Company will transmit Japanese messages to San Francisco by way of New York and then over its own Commercial cable to Manila. At Manila the Eastern extension sends them to Tokyo.

The Postal Telegraph Cable Company will transmit messages to St. Petersburg by the St. Petersburg-N.Y. cable, and thence by the St. Petersburg-Tokyo cable. By telegraph and cable they will be forwarded to London, where the Eastern Telegraph Company will transmit them across the Continent to the Russian capital.

Messages intended for Tokyo will be sent from Portsmouth to San Francisco, where they will be turned over to the Commercial Pacific Cable Company, which will carry them as far as Manila, via Honolulu, the Midway Islands and Guam. At Manila the Eastern extension takes them and sends them to Nagasaki, whence they are forwarded by telegraph to Tokyo.

Diplomatic Messages.

The sending, receiving, recording and transcribing of diplomatic cable messages is a slow process, although the transmission of the messages is done very swiftly. Each country has its special code. The messages, as written out, represent a series of groups of figures. Thus the figure 0257, following a code word, might represent "Nothing doing," or phrase of even greater length. The secretary would first have to make up the desired message into these combinations of five-figure groups.

After they have been transmitted to the other side and received by the home Governments another secretary would have to take these groups of figures, and following the key word in the code book, write out the full message.

This, as may be imagined, is a tedious task, and if there is a great deal of communication between the envoys and their Governments the time consumed in sending and receiving messages will materially lengthen the time of the conference.

In addition to the official messages to be sent, elaborate preparations have been made for the sending of press matter to all quarters of the earth. Press correspondents are arriving from Japan and all European countries, not to speak of the small number to represent American newspapers.
