The order for the British Mediterranean Squadron to go to Spain countermanded.

New York, 6.—Gold Exchange steady.

LONDON, 7.

The Queen in proroguing Parliament alludes with favor to the renewal of Reciprocity between the United States and Canada, and laments the condition of Spain, but favors non-interference.

MacMahon, in a Superior Council of War, demanded immediate credit of 4 million francs, and eventual credit of one milliard for arming purposes.

At secret convention concluded three months ago between King William and Serrano it was agreed that Germany would aid suppression of the Carlists if necessary and recognize the Republic. Spain in return to be the ally of Germany in case of war with France; Italy to be a third party to the alliance.

A Cricket match between eleven of the Princes' Club and twenty-two Americans resulted in 110 in one innings for Jonathan, and 60 in two innings for the English. This is the second victory for the Americans.

LONDON, August 10.

Two German war vessels sailed for Spain.

It is stated that Serrano notified the people that Spanish Government intend to declare a blockade of Gulf of Calabria and that England has protested against it.

Pius will appoint for new Cardinals shortly.

Hyacinth resigned his charge in Geneva on account of dissension in the Old Catholic party.

PARIS, 11.

Three is great excitement here since the news of the escape of Bazaine was received. Details are unknown but that he got free by the aid of a rope ladder on Sunday, during a storm. Government will act promptly and energetically in punishing all concerned in his flight.

New York, 11.—Gold 109½. Admiral Cochrane and entire British Squadron has been ordered to San Jose, Guatemala to demand reparation for the flogging of Council Magee.

A Fort Garry despatch of the 30th ult. says: Further accounts from various sections of the Province (Manitoba) show that the first reports of grasshoppers were greatly exaggerated. The crops will yield more than half—Several places were not visited; None west of here. All are rapidly travelling eastward.

A Hong Kong letter states that the invasion of the island of Formosa by the Japanese is considered as but the opening of a war which will result in a struggle between China and Japan.
