FIRE DESTROYED LIVERY STABLE

First Street, North of C.N.R., Scene of Destructive Blaze this Morning.

One of the most difficult fires that the city brigade has had to fight for many months broke out this morning shortly before ten o'clock in the C.N.R. livery and feed barn on First street, just north of the C.N.R. tracks. The building, where the fire broke out, was a two-story structure and was used for storing hay and feed. It was about 140 feet long and the other side about 100 feet, while each had a width of about 60 feet.
