Smart afternoon frock with embroidered bodice and apron. The enormous butterfly bow adds a graceful bustle effect.



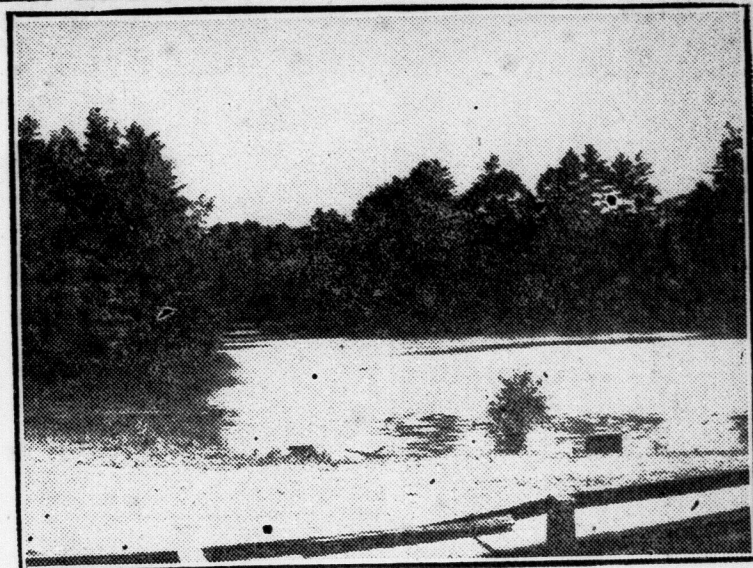

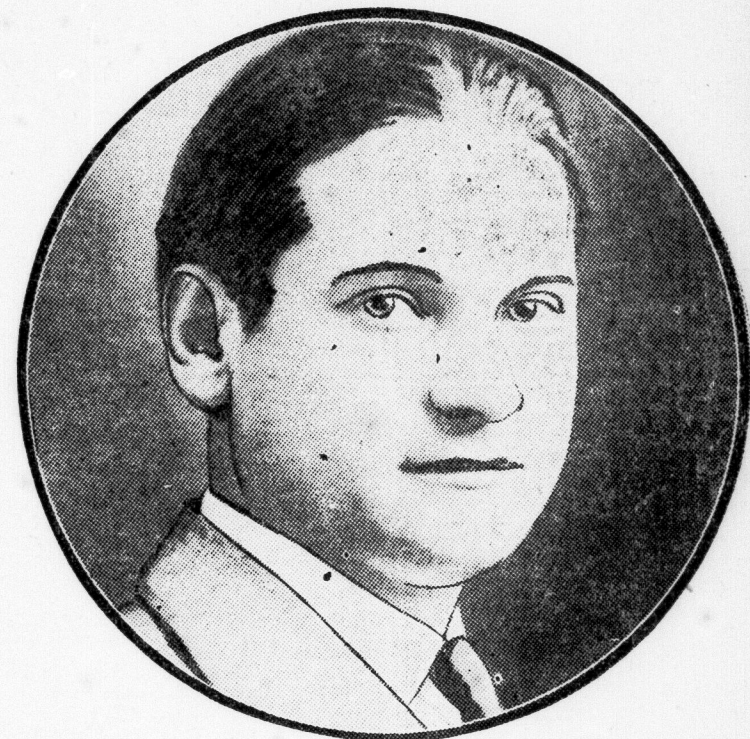
Col. T. W. Miller, former United States alien property custodian, who, with others, has been indicted of trying to defraud the government of over seven millions.

Giulio Cesare Nardella, former textile mill worker of Burlington, N. J., who has returned from vocal studying in Italy, where he was sent by the great Caruso.



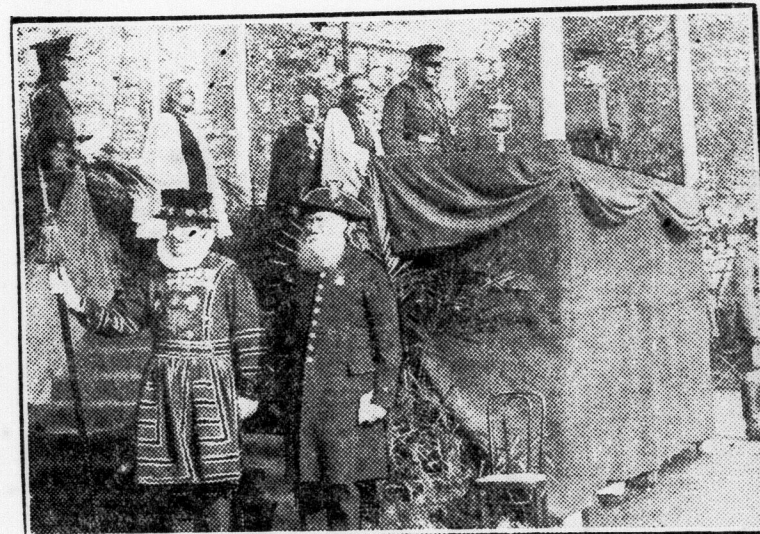

Sir Thomas and Lady Gratton Esmonde sail for home after a hunting trip on this continent.

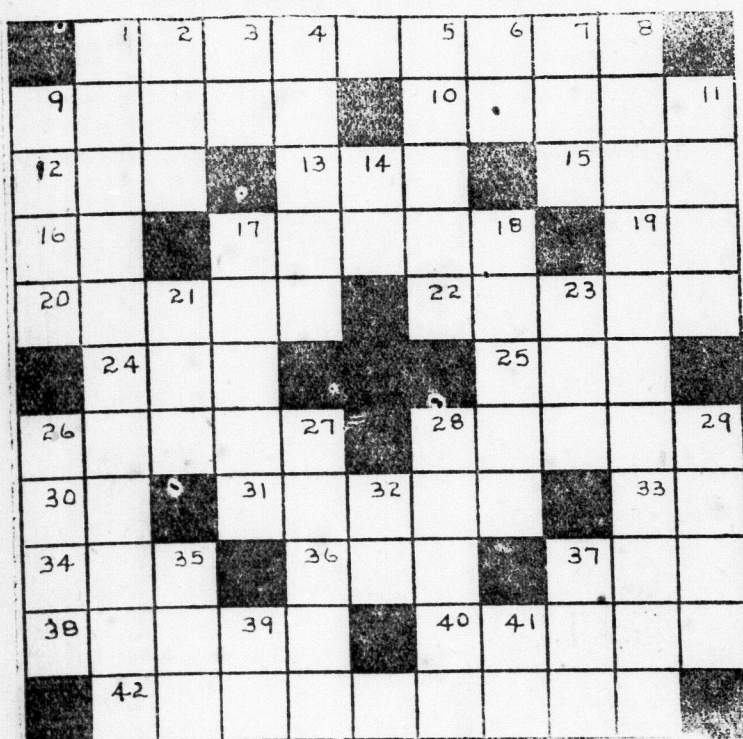


Miss Gladys Scherer, captain of the football team of Upsala Ladies' College, East Orange, N. J. The squad has challenged any other girls' aggregation in the east.

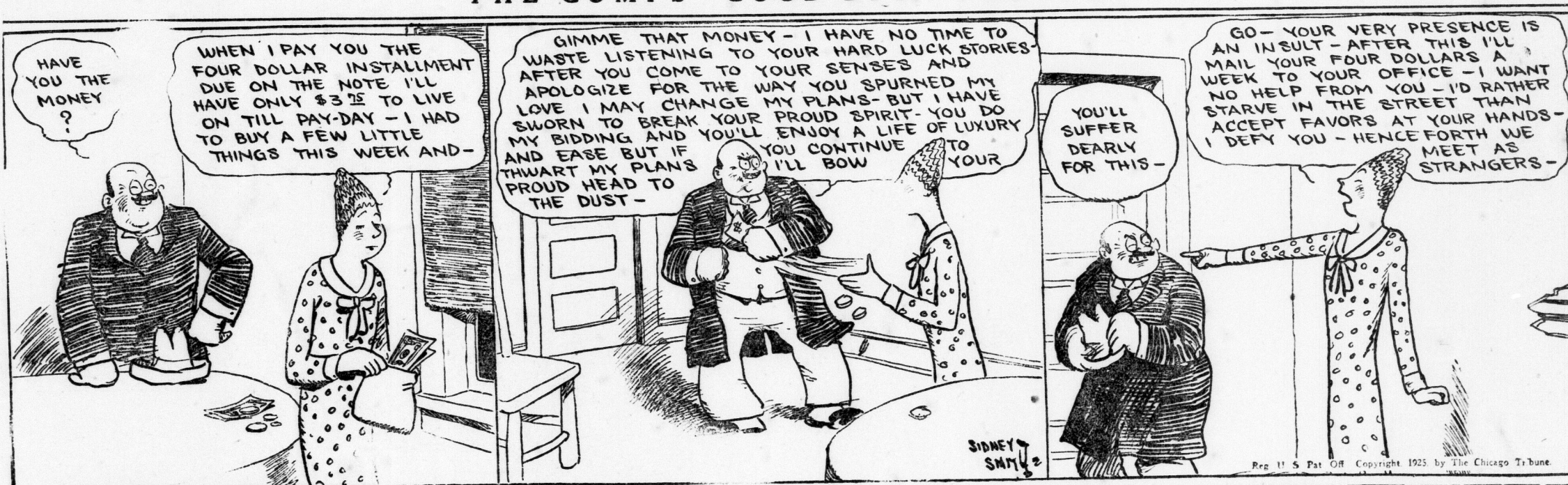
