Beacon at Sidney Folt Easier Seen-Painting Should be Reversed. A notice has been issued by the de-partment of marine and fisficries, telling of the fact that the buoy at Sidney spit was blown down a month ago. The Quadra was to have re-erected this beacon. Local steamboatmen say that when re-established the black and white on the buoy should be reversed in posi-tion, for if the bottom were painted black it would be visible better against the sea, and the white top would be bet-ter seen against the dark background made by the trees; whereas now, with the white bottom and black top, the sameness of ground obscures the beacon; in fact, as a local navigator puts it, the beacon has been visible for a longer distance since blown upside dow. In consequence of the severe weather. It has been found impracticable to promptly re-establish the pile beacon marking the outer edge of Sturgeon bank, of Sandheads lighthouse, Gulf of Georgia, reported disappeared in notice to mariners No. St of 1900, says another just issued notice. 




