WEEKLY WEATHER SYNOPSIS.

WEEKLY WEATHER SYNOPSIS.

Victoria Meteorological Office, 4th to 10th September, 1901.

With the exception of one heavy shower, no rain has been reported on Vancouver Island during the week. This shower was entirely confined to this locality, and was the first rain that had fallen since 21st of July, a period of 45 days. Only three times in the last 27 years has this long spell of drought been equalled or exceeded in Victoria, viz: in 1895, 45 days. During the whole week until the evening of the 10th, the barometer has been high over Vancouver Island. On the 7th a depression developed over Cariboo, which hovered there during the remainder of the week, and extending at the close across the Rockies into the Northwest Territories. Both at Kamloops and Barkerville nearly half an inch of rain fell and light frosts were reported from Cariboo. Temperatures have been moderately high on the islands, the lower Mainiand and in Cariboo but have continued warmer in the valley of the Thompson. The first snow of the season fell on Friday. 6th inst., in the Rossland district, when Mt. Roberts donned its first, winter coating, being 10 days earlier than occurred in 1900.

Bush fire smoke has been prevalent on the Straits and the islands, and occasional fog has occurred. In the Northwest the changes have been frequent and extensive. At the beginning of the week a pronounced low area covered the Territories. This was quickly followed on the 6th by a yast area of high pressure, which extended from the ocean appeared and gradually developing, forced the high area altogether to the eastward of the great lakes.
