THE MAD OF THE MIST

The Only Survivor's Story of the Famous  
Letter in New York Tribune

I think it was in 1861 that James W. Buchanan of Toronto went to live in Southampton Bridge. The original Mad of the Mist had just been destroyed, and Mr. Buchanan, who had plenty of means, thought that it would be a good idea to build a new one, better than the other one and more durable. She was 150x16 feet over all. Buchanan's money held out until the time came to place the engine and boiler. It was then that Buchanan's money failed him. He had to go to the bank and borrow sufficient money from old Judge Atkinson to complete the boat, and a mortgage on it for \$7000 was given to him. The old judge thought his venture was perfectly safe, and so did every one else. He had to go to the bank and borrow sufficient money from old Judge Atkinson to complete the boat, and a mortgage on it for \$7000 was given to him. The old judge thought his venture was perfectly safe, and so did every one else. One outlet for steam was blocked by the great cascade and the other by the boiler which was too small to be of any use.
