For the Nation The Amesbury Abbey property of Sir William Antrobus in Wiltshire, of which Stonehenge forms a part, has been placed in the hands of Messrs. Knight, Frank and Burley for sale by private contract, but it is a condition of the sale that Stonehenge shall not be included but shall be preserved for the nation. The War Office owns a large portion of Salisbury Plain and Colonel Seeley has been informed of the approaching sale. Stonehenge is the oldest, most imposing, and most mysterious of British prehistoric remains. The most probable theory is that it was meant as a temple for sun worship and that the stones were placed in their present position between 1800 and 1600 B.C. From excavations it is known that there was a great cemetery in the age of bronze on Salisbury Plain, and at this temple the last honors may have been rendered to the dead.
