MINISTER LALONDE: There is no House of Lords on these any more.

MEMBER OF THE PRESS: If you were framing questions to be put to the people of Quebec in a Federally sponsored referendum, how would you put those questions?

MINISTER LALONDE: Well, again, that is a little premature as a question. But I think if you were to ask about the choice, it should be a clear choice between independence and the Federal system, or Federalists. We don't believe — and I am glad to see that more and more Separatists are recognizing this — I think even Mr. Levesque said, recently in an interview, "There is no half-way-house between Federalism and independence."
