

Traditional project-based TC

The much-criticized traditional model of technical cooperation is certain to continue in existence for some time in many countries in which circumstances are not yet propitious for the newer TC roles. Where the “expert and counterpart in a project” model does continue, it can be improved in practice by “establishing a true partnership, where partners are considered to be equal and where each has clearly defined functions and... whereby expatriate advisors share technical knowledge and at the same time learn from their counterparts about the cultural, political, and social context of their work.”⁵⁵
