The Committee recommends that the Government of Canada meet annually with the other parties to all Nuclear Co-operation Agreements to review the application of such Agreements, and table a report on the results of such meetings in Parliament.

Response

Bilateral nuclear consultations, to review the implementation of bilateral Nuclear Co-operation Agreements (NCAs) and to discuss bilateral and multilateral nuclear policy issues of mutual interest, are held regularly with those nuclear partners with which Canada has significant nuclear co-operation. The Government will continue this practice, although not necessarily at an annual pace for each country. The Government undertakes to keep Parliament appropriately informed, bearing in mind the very real limitations caused by the fact that consultations between the Government of Canada and the Governments of other countries are confidential.
