

Application of the Act to persons who are not insured persons

28. (1) The provisions of the Act apply to a person who is not insured under the Act if the person is a resident of the province of Ontario and is employed in a business, profession, occupation or vocation in Ontario.

(2) The provisions of the Act apply to a person who is not insured under the Act if the person is a resident of the province of Ontario and is employed in a business, profession, occupation or vocation in Ontario and the person is not insured under the Act because of the provisions of section 27.

(3) The provisions of the Act apply to a person who is not insured under the Act if the person is a resident of the province of Ontario and is employed in a business, profession, occupation or vocation in Ontario and the person is not insured under the Act because of the provisions of section 27 and the person is not insured under the Act because of the provisions of section 28.

(4) The provisions of the Act apply to a person who is not insured under the Act if the person is a resident of the province of Ontario and is employed in a business, profession, occupation or vocation in Ontario and the person is not insured under the Act because of the provisions of section 27 and the person is not insured under the Act because of the provisions of section 28 and the person is not insured under the Act because of the provisions of section 29.

(5) The provisions of the Act apply to a person who is not insured under the Act if the person is a resident of the province of Ontario and is employed in a business, profession, occupation or vocation in Ontario and the person is not insured under the Act because of the provisions of section 27 and the person is not insured under the Act because of the provisions of section 28 and the person is not insured under the Act because of the provisions of section 29 and the person is not insured under the Act because of the provisions of section 30.

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Clause 28: Table 1 of the schedule requires

- (a) at least ten weeks of insurable employment where the applicable regional rate of unemployment is more than 15.0 per cent; and
- (b) at least eleven weeks where that rate is more than 14.0 per cent but not more than 15.0 per cent.

The amendment would require at least twelve weeks of insurable employment in those cases.

Article 28. — Le tableau 1 de l'annexe prévoit l'exigence :

- a) d'au moins dix semaines d'emploi assurable dans les cas où le taux régional de chômage est de plus de 15,0 pour cent;
- b) d'au moins onze semaines dans les cas où le taux est de plus de 14,0 pour cent jusqu'à 15,0 pour cent.
