One lifts nations onto a higher platform of social purity, brings woman out of degradation, and purifies the atmosphere of Legislative halls and Judicial benches, as is the case with Great Britain. The other sinks nations into the lowest forms of immorality; degrades woman, making her a mere toy and slave to man's lusts; and makes the will of a Tyrant the law of the people, as is the case with Turkey. He strives with all his might to get the Theatre into the Church, and to get the Church into the Thea-For he knows that if he can get the Theatre into the Church, the Church's Spiritual Power will be gone, and she will become a Nursery for the Theatre, and if he can get the Church into the Theatre, he knows that immorality will have a glamour of respectability thrown over it that will most effectively; allure the unwary and inexperienced on to eternal doom.

I am not an old man, but I have had a good deal of personal acquaintance with this BELIAR, and can say with Paul, "We are not ignorant of his devices."
