CHAPTER 157

AN ACT RESPECTING THE ROYAL BANK OF CANADA [Assented to 13th July, 1906]

THEREAS the Royal Bank of Canada has by its petition Preamble prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore His 1869, c. 59; 1870, Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and c. 43; 1900, cc. 103, 104 House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:-

1. The chief office of the Royal Bank of Canada is hereby Place of changed from the City of Halifax, in the Province of Nova Scotia, chief office changed to the City of Montreal, in the Province of Quebec.

2. The provisions of chapter 59 of the statutes of 1869, intituled Acts An Act to incorporate the Merchants Bank of Halifax, and any amended amendments of the said Act, in so far as they are inconsistent with this Act, are hereby repealed.

3. This Act shall not take effect unless and until it has been When Act to submitted to a general or special meeting of the shareholders of come into the said bank and is approved of by a majority of the votes of the shareholders present or represented by proxy at such meeting and entitled to vote thereat, and provided that notice of such meeting and of the proposed change of head office was duly given; and thereupon the foregoing sections of this Act shall come into force upon the publication thereof in the Canada Gazette, and the Secretary of State of Canada shall cause them to be so published upon receiving a certificate under the hand of the president and the seal
