The government and the Auditor General are in agreement that a prime means of facilitating accountability is through an information system which provides the bridge between the estimates and the public accounts committee. The end result will be consistency—

Mr. Speaker: I can only indicate that, in the face of these circumstances, I immediately leave the chair. I want to extend to all members of the House my deep gratitude for the co-operation and support they have extended to the Chair throughout this rather long period of time. If any members are so inclined I will be awaiting their attendance in room 16.
