No mason can be interred with the formalities of the order, unless it be at his own special request, nor unless he has been advanced to the degree of a master mason. When the wish of the deceased shall have been communicated to the master of the Lodge of which he died a member, the master may apply to the grand master for a dispensation.

A DISPENSATION having been obtained, the master may invite other Lodges to attend in form, but the whole ceremony, unless the grand master or his deputy, he present, must be under the direction of the master of the Lodge to which the deceased belonged; and he is accountable for the regularity and conduct of the whole proceeding. THE Lodges rank according to seniority, the junior preceding, (except the Lodge to which the deceased belonged, which in every case is to go the last) and each Lodge forms one division.
