And whereas unnecessary delay in accounting to the Provincial Treasurer for the Revenue, may be detrimental to the same, Be it therefore enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the Secretary of the Province shall use efficient means of compelling all persons employed by or under him, as his Agents or Deputies, in acceiving and collecting the Duties imposed by virtue of this Act, or by virtue of any other Act or Acts of the Parliament of this Province, to transmit to him, from time to time, without delay, all such monies as they shall so receive and collect; and that the said Secretary of the Province, shall pay into the hands of the said Provincial Treasurer, all monies which he shall from time to time so receive, or otherwise collect as Duties imposed by this Act, or by any other Act or Acts of the Parliament of this Province, within one calendar month after he shall have received or collected the same, any Act, Law or Usage to the contrary notwish standing.
