## MANITOBA HOCKEY ASSOCIATION OFFICERS

Decides to Remain Free From Manitoba Amateur Athletic Association.

BRANDON, Man., Dec. 22.—The annual meeting of the Manitoba Hockey Association was held at the Y.M.C.A. There was a splendid representation of about twenty teams from all parts of the province. The election of officers resulted as follows:

Hon. president, George Penwick of Wawanesa; president, Dr. J. S. Matheson of Brandon; vice-president, George Manson, Jr., Strathclair; secretary-treasurer, H. Morris, Brandon; executive council, J. A. Taylor (Bolesvaine), C. Foster (Wawanesa), A. Sexsmith (Portage la Prairie), and Geo. McQuirter (Minnedosa).

The financial statement showed a credit balance of \$10.

A lengthy discussion took place on the amateur trouble, and it was decided not to join the Manitoba Amateur Athletic Association, but to run the association on purely amateur lines.

The secretary's annual report showed that there were twenty-seven teams outside of Brandon members of the association last year, and these were divided into six districts, the championship of the province finally going to Strathclair. It transpired that further teams intended joining the association this year. A motion was put thru accepting Manitou into membership of the association.

**TORONTO DRIVING CLUB PROGRAM OF RACES CHANGED.**  
The recent favorable change in the weather has stimulated interest in the ice races, which begin Christmas Day at Hillcrest Park, and now everything points to a most favorable opening. The executive of the Toronto Driving Club, at a meeting held Saturday afternoon, decided to change the original program and put on the 2.18 trot instead of the 2.30 pace Wednesday.
