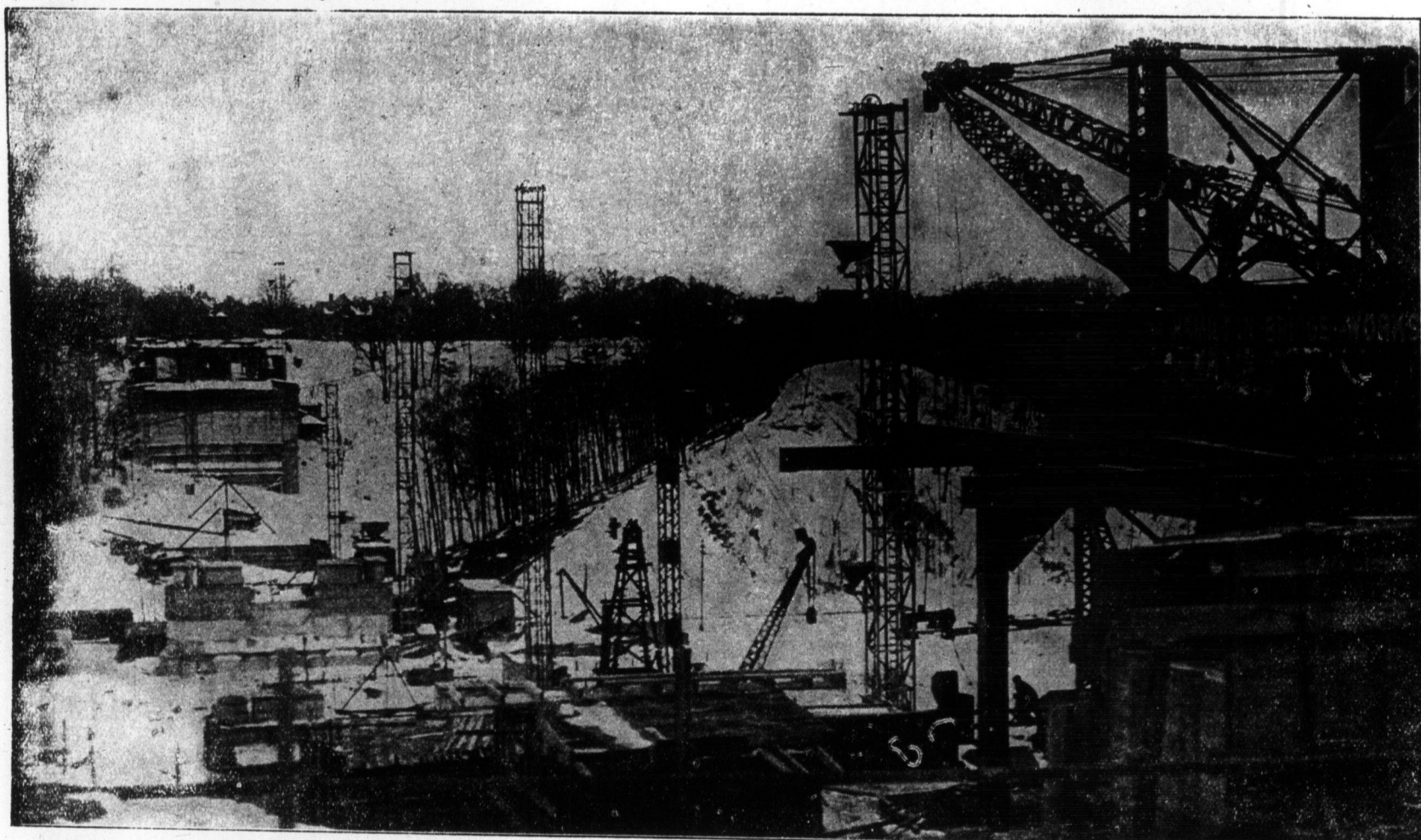

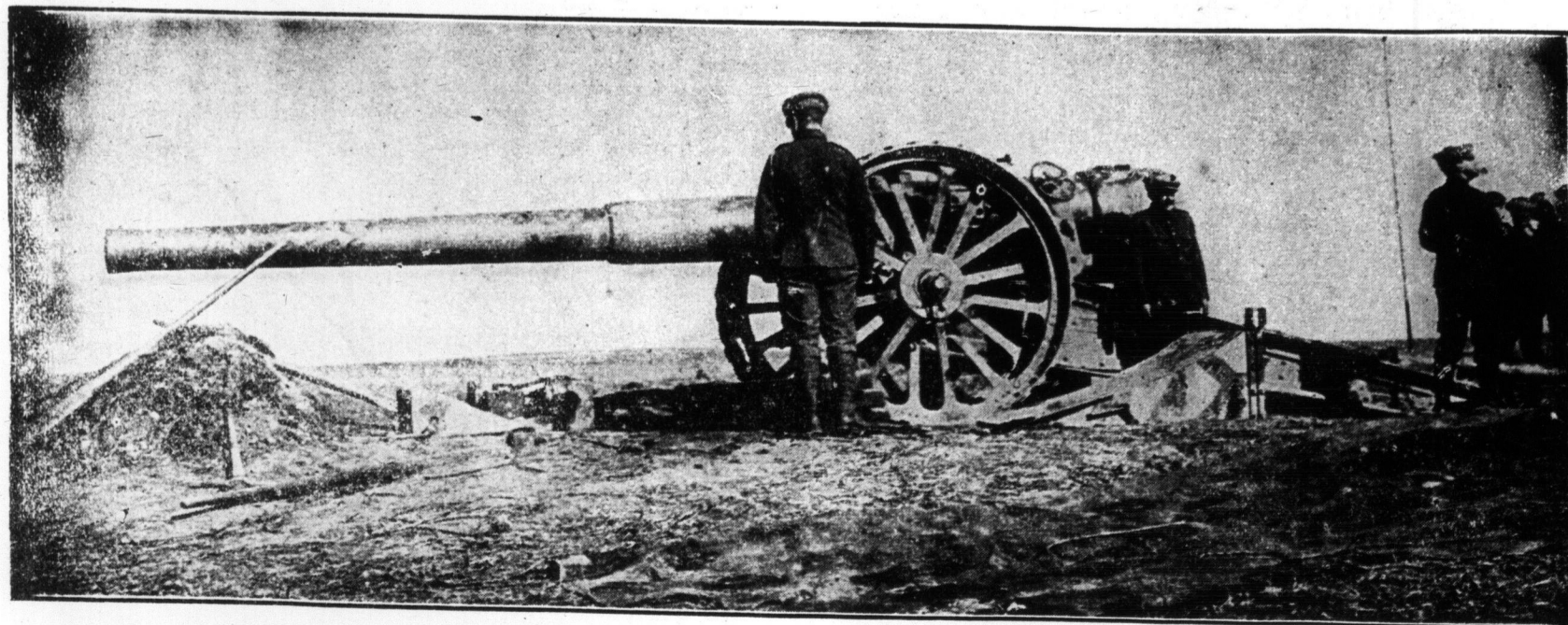

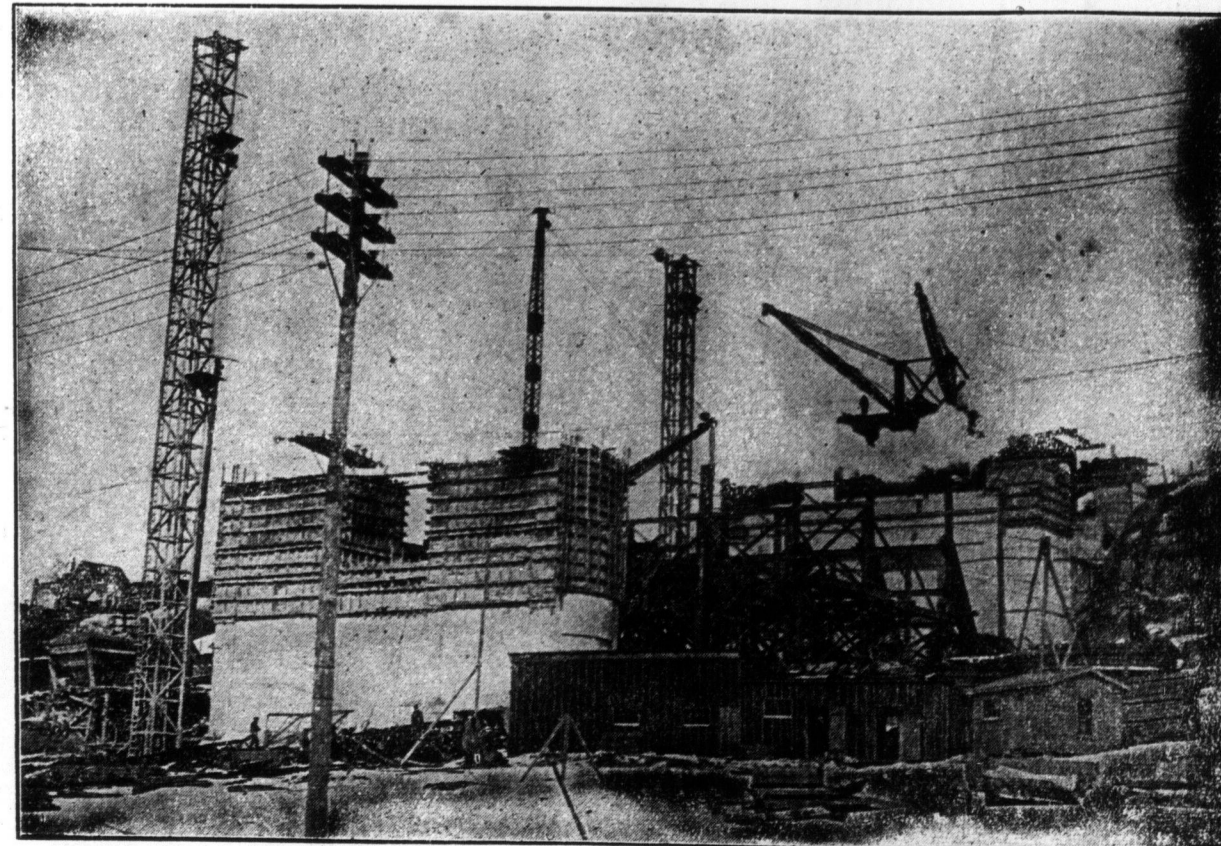
Rushing work on the new Bloor street viaduct. One of many views showing the progress of this important civic improvement.
