We recently wrote the railway commissioner,
objecting to private crossing signs being
erected by the C. N. R. on their spare line, from
First to Seventh Sts.

We have a copy of the letter written to the
Commissioner, saying that the matter is under con-
sideration by your department.

All maps and plans that we have seen do not
show that the C. N. R. right-of-way, occupying the
streets crossing, of which they have taken possession.
