"BUY AT HOME" CAMPAIGN

(Halifax Chronicle)

One of the most important campaigns in years is about to be launched in Nova Scotia - the "Buy at Home" campaign. Before the people the advantage of buying goods from their own local merchants and the harm to the community of buying from the merchants of other provinces. If it succeeds in stopping the flood of money that is now being transferred from the province and sapping the life of the rural districts, thousands of dollars will be saved to our province and it will have an opportunity to grow big and strong. It is believed this movement will have the hearty support of the whole community. The promoter of the campaign is T. H. Curry, an advertising expert of Halifax. He says the campaign which is to start simultaneously in the leading towns and cities of Nova Scotia, April 1, is being backed by a group of business men in each community. The plan is to publish in the newspapers of the province a series of some fifty carefully written and convincing articles setting forth the fundamental economic reasons why money should be spent at home. If there is to be prosperity at home, advance copies of these articles have been received and they outline the danger to the community in the mail-order habit and the earnest desire to do something really constructive for the province. They show exhaustive study and undoubtedly will prove a most salutary influence in turning the attention from the catalogue to the stores of our home-town merchants. The campaign is now ready to be presented to the public.
