BABY BORN TO DR. AND MRS. JOS. A. BLAKE IN PARIS

New York, July 15.—The news that a baby was born two weeks ago in Paris to Dr. Joseph A. Blake and his wife, who was Mrs. Clarence Mackay, was brought to New York by passengers of the French liner Rochambeau.

Dr. Blake is now the head of the American Ambulance Hospital in Paris. Dr. Blake was divorced in December, 1914 after his wife had started and then dropped a suit for \$1,000,000 against Mrs. Mackay, charging alienation of her husband's affections.

He went to Paris, secured a house near that of Mrs. Mackay and their wedding followed in November of that year.

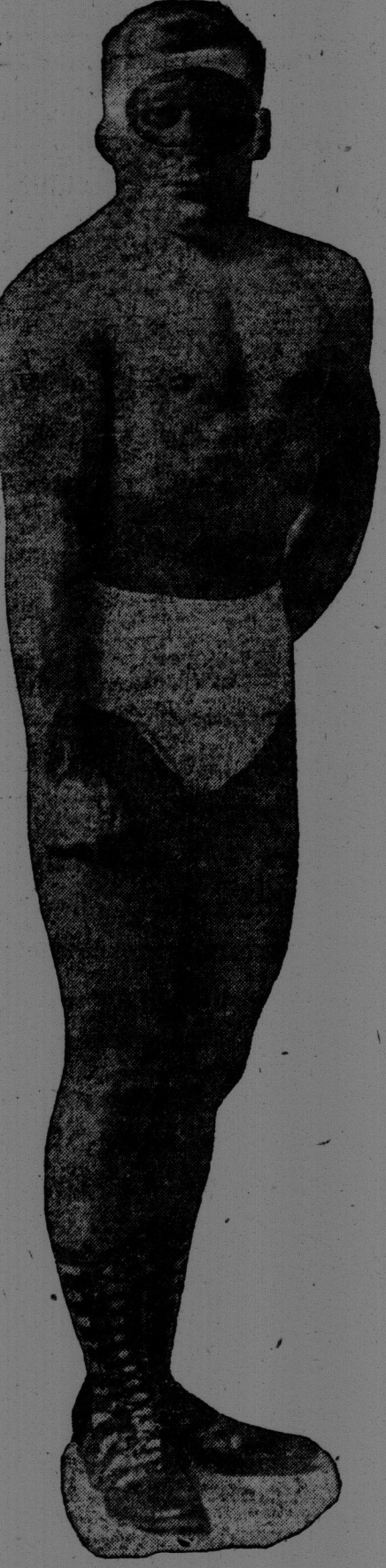
