London, June 28—(Associated Press by Mail)—A novel working arrangement on the "no peace, no pay" principle has been entered into by the British government with the Wahabi, a powerful Arabian desert tribe. The Wahabi are nomads and belong to a sect which Colonial Secretary Winston Churchill described in the House of Commons as "bearing the same relation to orthodox Islam as the most militant forms of Calvinism would have borne to Rome in the fiercest times of the religious wars."

Put Across Road.




