SCHOOL TO PREPARE SOLDIERS AS TEACHERS

(Toronto Mail and Empire.) The proposed school of instruction to enable returned soldiers to enter the teaching profession promises to be a marked success. Some time ago Hon. Dr. Cody, minister of education, appointed Major Harris, B. A., to arrange for an attendance at the courses and to bring the opportunities they afforded for an educational career to the attention of returned soldiers. Major Harris has done his work thoroughly and well. He has already reported more than 300 applications from those who are willing to consider the question of entering the teaching profession. Many of the applicants reside in Toronto, and many elsewhere throughout the province. Down to date seventy-eight applications from candidates have been accepted, and the work of determining the qualifications of the applicants is still going on. LAND OF HIDDEN FLAGS

Italian Colors Concealed in Istra Wait-ing for Freedom.

Having recently visited every part of Istra, I have found it the land of hidden flags—Italian flags, which had been con-cealed in nooks and corners, in attic or cellar, for years or decades, in some cases for more than a century since the time of Napoleon, awaiting the time when they might again be thrown loose from windows and masts to welcome the soldiers of Italy.

What Lorraine and Alsace have been to France, the Trentino and Istra have been to Italy. Formerly they were Italian territory, of old under the Roman Empire, later under the Venetian Re-public. Austria herself, after annexing commonly referred to this part of her domain as Italian Austria.

Just as in Alsace I found strong and numerous German elements, so in Istra there are more numerous though far less strong and intelligent Slavic ele-ments. In the country districts of the interior, the peasants are Croats, Ru-manians and Slovenes—but the cities and towns and the country districts of the coast are Italian—World Outlook.
