Constitution and By-Laws.

OBJECTS.

To provide Orphans and destitute children with a comfortable home, educational facilities and religious instruction during the time of their residence in the Institution, &c. (*See Act of Incorporation.*)

CONSTITUTION.

I.

The name of this Institution shall be "St. Paul's Alms House of Industry" which being endowed only to a limited extent, must necessarily be dependent on the contributions of the benevolent for maintenance.

It shall be managed by a Committee of Ladies and Gentlemen—the Rector being President—a Secretary and Treasurer.

BY-LAWS.

I.

The meeting of the Committee, convened by printed or written notices from the Secretary, shall be held on the last Tuesday of every month, at 4 p. m., at the Alms House, and shall be opened with Bible Reading and Prayer.

II.

The Committee shall collect for the Alms House every year, and hand in their monies to the Treasurer on or before the last Tuesday in May.

III.

The Secretary to keep the Minutes of business transacted at the meetings of the Committee, and perform such other duties as pertain to the office of Secretary.

IV.

The Treasurer shall keep an account of all monies received and paid, and shall pay no account unless authorized by the Committee. The accounts shall be audited previous to the published yearly report.
