GREAT FOOT BALL MATCH TODAY.

An Excited Crowd to Witness the Event.

SPRINGFIELD, Mass., Nov. 21.—The city is owned today by warring blue and crimson.

Hotels and streets have been crowded since morning and early and late trains have added thousands to the throng.

Weather for big foot ball game is perfect; cool and cloudy with light wind. Ticket speculators appear to have lost their occupation; seats held by the crowd.

Eight o'clock this afternoon down nearly to the ground level, the crowd is so dense that it is impossible to get a view of the game.

Most of the city streets are deserted. All other New England colleges are represented. Amherst and Williams sending largest delegations in special trains from the North.

Fourteen separate entrances provided for the rush and the work of placing the vast audience and seating those entitled to seats went on with little friction.

One hundred and sixty five uniformed officers were early on hand to preserve order.
