Summerside, a seaport post and money order town, capital of Prince Co, on the P. E. I. R., 49 miles from Charlottetown, fare \$1.45, contains about fifty stores, three hotels, two printing offices (each issuing a newspaper), one planing mill, three banks (the Summerside Bank, Merchants Bank of Halifax, Bank of Nova Scotia), one foundry, one tannery, Anglo-American telegraph and telephone exchange. It has a splendid harbor, and has daily communication in summer with New Brunswick and Nova Scotia. The Charlottetown Steam Navigation Co.'s steamers run here daily, except in the winter season. Summerside is in every respect the second town on the Island, and indeed its growth has been so rapid of late years that it bids fair to become soon a formidable rival to the provincial capital Its local position of course has much to do with its itself. prosperity; it is directly opposite Shediac, with which it has daily communication by the above-named steamers. Can. express, census 1891 shows a population of 2,883.

Summerville, a post village in Kings Co., contains three stores, Can. express, pop. 500.

Ten Mile House, a post office in Queens Co., Can. express.

Tignish, a post village in Prinee Co., on the Gulf of St. Lawrence, and terminus of the P. E. I. R., 12 miles from Alberton, fare 36 cts., fare from Summerside \$2.05, 117 miles from Charlottetown, fare \$3.50, large quantities of fish are shipped from here, contains seven stores, one hotel, two saw mills, two grist mills, P. E. I. telephone, Anglo American telegraph, one shingle mill, one carding mill, one cloth manufactury, Can. express, pop. 470.

Tracadie, a settlement and a station on the P. E. I. R., in Queens Co., 16 miles from Charlottetown, fare 48 cts, contains one store, Can. express, pop. 215.

Tracadie Cross, a post office in Queens Co., Can. express. Tracadie Grand, a post settlement in Queens Co., contains two stores, pop. 400.
