SECTION VIII.

TERMS.

I. The Academic year consists of Two Terms; the first (Michaelmas) extending from October 1st to December 22nd; and the second (Easter) from January 4th to May 31st.

2. The term will not be allowed to Students who have been reported to the President by any of the Professors as neglecting to attend the required Lectures; or who have not passed the prescribed Examinations, or have not conformed to the other Statutes or Regulations of the College, or have been reported to the Council for bad conduct.

SECTION IX.

COLLEGE EXAMINATIONS.

I. All Matriculated Students are required to attend the College Examinations in every department or branch prescribed by the University of Toronto as necessary for their respective standings.

2. Prizes and Honors are awarded in each department on the results of the Examinations at Easter, with additional Examinations at Christmas, at the discretion of each Professor or Lecturer.

3. Candidates for Prizes or Honors are arranged, according to their proficiency, in two classes, and those who are not Candidates for Prizes or Honors, or who fail to obtain Honors, are similarly arranged in the Third Class; but no name of a Candidate for Honors shall be entered on the Class Lists until he has passed in all the prescribed subjects.
