

Some Reasons Why the Foster Administration Should Be Kicked Out

Because while they received during each year they have been in power an average of \$190,742 more from territorial revenue than their predecessors received;

Because in the same time they received \$16,000 a year more on an average from Company taxation;

Because in the same time they received \$51,000 a year more on an average from Motor Vehicle fees;

Because they put a new tax on every child in the province who wants to go to a picture or any other show, and received \$73,511 from that source;

Because they put a new tax on all the wildernesses lands in the province and raised \$147,587 from that source;

Because they put additional taxes on the widows and orphans by increasing the Succession duties, and reducing the exemption from estates not exceeding \$50,000 to not exceeding \$25,000;

Because while their total revenue from all sources has averaged \$459,830 more in each year than their predecessors ever received;

Yet, in spite of all this additional income, they piled up in three years of their administration a deficit of \$802,000 odd.

On the top of this big deficit, they borrowed and borrowed, till they had added over FIVE MILLION DOLLARS to the public debt of the province.
