ATTENTION has often been drawn to the fact that Trinity is the University of the Church for the Province of Ontario in the sense that it was founded by Churchmen, endowed by Churchmen, officered by Churchmen, intended primarily, though not exclusively, for Churchmen, and that it is governed by Churchmen. This last fact, however, has not been specially emphasized in any previous issue of the Year Book, and it is therefore thought desirable to place it on record here in permanent form.
